

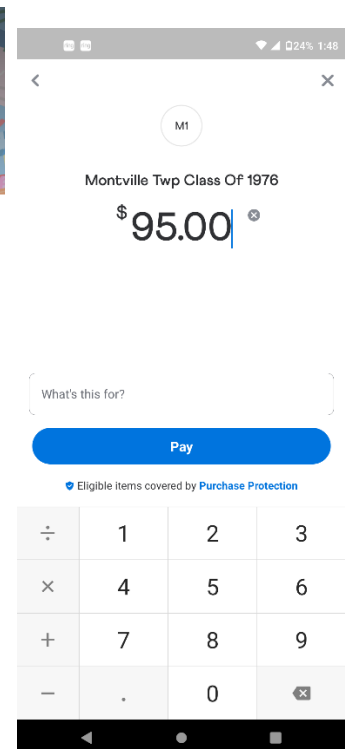
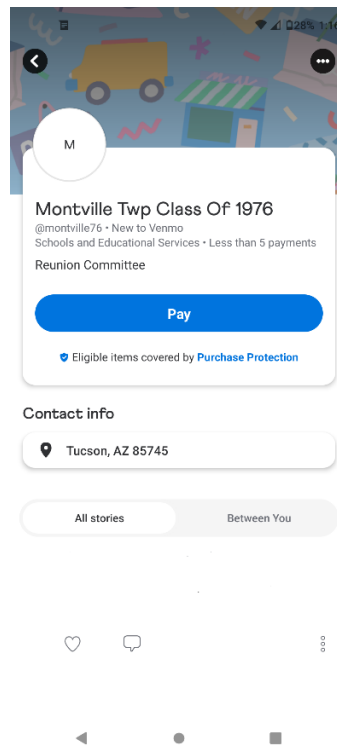
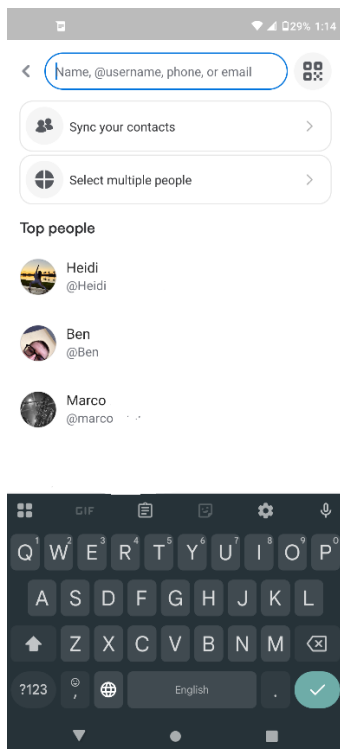
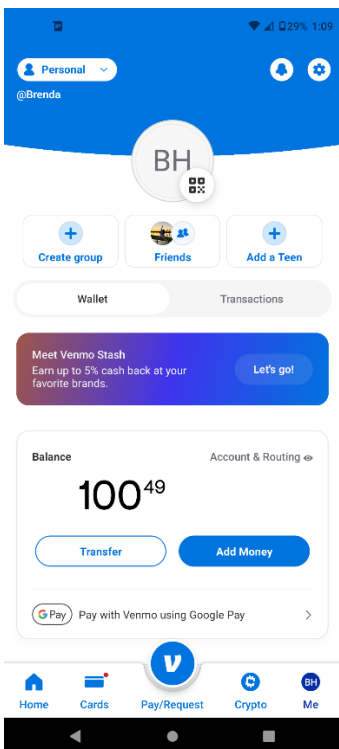
How to pay with Venmo

Venmo is an app that allows you to use your phone to transfer money to or from other people using just their phone number, email address, or keyword. It acts much like a bank account in that you can add money to your Venmo account, or transfer money out of your Venmo account and into your regular bank. You don't HAVE to keep money in the Venmo account – if your balance is zero and you want to pay someone, Venmo will just take it out of your bank. In order to do this, you have to:

1. Download the Venmo app from the Apple store or Google play to your phone. There is also a website interface if you just want to use Venmo from your computer, just go to www.venmo.com and follow the prompts.
2. Set up your Venmo account by giving the Venmo app permission to access your bank account or credit card. There are instructions for doing this on the Venmo site (<https://help.venmo.com/cs/home>).

To pay for reunion tickets:

1. When you're ready to send money, open up the app and click the Large V button (Pay/Request) on the bottom of the screen.
2. Enter the username for the reunion (@montville76) in the field at the top of the screen to call up the list of Montville Venmo accounts. You'll need to scroll down a bit to the "businesses", then click on Montville Twp Class of 1976.
3. The next screen lets you confirm that this is who you want to pay. Click Pay.
4. Enter the amount you want to pay (\$95 per ticket) then enter some descriptive text. If you're requesting more than one ticket, you might put in the name of your plus-one, or any other note in the box "What's this for?".



5. Click Pay again. This is your last chance to confirm that you are sending money to the correct place. It should say Montville Twp Class of 1976, show the message you entered about the payment, and also display your Venmo balance (if any).
6. Final time – click Pay \$95 (or whatever your amount is). That’s it, you’re done. You’ll probably see an ad, and depending on how you set up your Venmo account, you will probably also get an email saying “You paid Montville Twp Class of 1976 \$95”.
